

GENOCID U SREBRENICI KROZ PRESUDE KRIVIČNIH SUDOVA

U julu 1995. godine, Vojska Republike Srpske (VRS) izvršila je napad na Srebrenicu, grad u istočnoj Bosni i Hercegovini (BiH). U samo nekoliko dana više od 8 hiljada dječaka i muškaraca prisilno je odvedeno, zatvoreno, zlostavljan, mučeno i potom ubijeno zbog njihove etničke i religijske pripadnosti kao bosanskih Muslimana. U pozadini hiljada tijela u masovnim grobnicama, nastajao je sistem spreman da negira ove zločine.

"Nakon što je Srebrenica u julu 1995. pala u ruke srpskih snaga koje su je opsjedale, izgleda da se desio zaista strašan masakr muslimanskog stanovništva. Dokazi koje je podnijelo Tužilaštvo opisuju scene nezamislivog divljaštva: na hiljade muškaraca pogubljenih i zatrpanih u masovne grobnice, na stotine živih sahranjenih muškaraca, muškarci i žene sakaćeni i zaklani, djeca ubijana pred očima svojih majki, jed primoran da jede jetru svog unuka. Ovo su istinske scene iz pakla, pisane na najmračnijim stranicama ljudske istorije".

Radna Grupa Komisije za istraživanje događaja u i oko Srebrenice od 10. do 19. jula 1995. godine, formirana od strane Vlade bosanskohercegovačkog entiteta Republike Srpske, je 2004. godine utvrdila da je 20.150 osoba direktno ili indirektno učestvovalo u pripremi i realizaciji genocida u Srebrenici.

Međunarodni sud pravde je 2007. godine presudio da je država Srbija prekršila Konvenciju o sprječavanju i kažnjavanju zločina genocida time što nije učinila sve što je bilo u njenoj moći da spriječi genocid, nije kaznila niti predala počinioce MKSJ, te je prekršila svoje obaveze da poštuje privremene mjere koje je odredio Sud.

Međunarodni krivični sud za bivšu Jugoslaviju (MKSJ), Sud Bosne i Hercegovine i sudovi u Srbiji osudili su više od pedeset osoba na više od 700 godina zatvora za zločine počinjene u Srebrenici. Od dvadeset i jedne presude MKSJ-a za zločine počinjene u Srebrenici, osam uključuje i presude za zločin genocida. Sud BiH donjeo je 25 presuda za zločine počinjene u Srebrenici, od čega je trinaest za zločin genocida. U Republici Srbiji doneseno je pet presuda koje se odnose na Srebrenicu, uključujući presude za ratne zločine protiv civilnog stanovništva i kršenje zakona i običaja ratovanja.

THE GENOCIDE IN SREBRENICA THROUGH LEGAL JUDGEMENTS

In July 1995, the Army of the Republika Srpska, known as the VRS, invaded the town of Srebrenica in eastern Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH). In a few horrific days, more than 8,000 Bosnian Muslim boys and men were taken to places of detention, abused, tortured, and then executed. As their bodies were falling into mass graves, a machine primed to deny those very crimes was being set into motion.

"After Srebrenica fell to besieging Serbian forces in July 1995, a truly terrible massacre of the Muslim population appears to have taken place. The evidence tendered by the Prosecutor describes scenes of unimaginable savagery: thousands of men executed and buried in mass graves, hundreds of men buried alive, men and women mutilated and slaughtered, children killed before their mothers' eyes, a grandfather forced to eat the liver of his own grandson. These are truly scenes from hell, written on the darkest pages of human history."

In 2004, a working group which was a part of the Commission for investigating crimes in and around Srebrenica that occurred from 10 to 19 July 1995, proved that 21,150 people directly or indirectly took part in the preparations and fulfillment of the Srebrenica genocide. The Commission for investigating these crimes in and around Srebrenica was established by the Government of the Republika Srpska.

In 2007, the International Court of Justice found that Serbia had committed a breach of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide by failing to prevent the genocide from occurring, for not cooperating with the ICTY in punishing the perpetrators of the genocide, and for violating its obligation to comply with the provisional measures ordered by the Court.

The International Tribunal for Former Yugoslavia (ICTY), Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Serbian courts have sentenced more than fifty people to more than 700 years in prison for crimes committed in Srebrenica. Of the twenty-one judgments the ICTY made about crimes committed in Srebrenica, eight contained guilty verdicts for the crime of genocide. Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina passed 25 judgements for crimes committed in Srebrenica, and thirteen of those judgements included the crime of genocide. And in the Republic of Serbia, five judgements relating to Srebrenica have been delivered, including for war crimes against the civilian population and violations of the laws and customs of war.
